- Bond Update
 - Series 1 \$190 million
 - New Smith Middle School
 - On track for opening 2026/2027
 - o On budget
 - Troy High School
 - Re-worked athletic facilities, including restrooms and concessions
 - Athens High School
 - Constructions begins in summer 2025 for baseball/softball
 - Redesigning the front and adding a new academic wing Athens has no windows currently – construction will begin in 2026
 - Boulan Park & Larson Renovations
 - Fall 2026 Boulan Park will move into old Smith Middle School and in Fall 2027, Larson will move into the old Smith Middle School
 - Playground Enhancements
 - \$700,000 per school
 - Hamilton update starts 5/19
 - Furniture
 - All elementary schools will have updated playground and new furniture after this summer
- Budget Update
 - Budget and finance is tied to enrollment birth rate is declining 2005/2006 had \$9200 per student; not keeping up with rate of inflation – working to right size in terms of our sizing
- Attendance Area Review In final phase, all information has been gathered and board has to review the information
 - Goals
 - Goal 1: Right-size middle schools, equal student ratios
 - Goal 2: Resolve double splits
 - Goal 3: No impact on high school
- Multi Tiered Systems of Support (MTSS) Making sure kids have access to high quality teaching on a regular basis
