

Career-Technical Bilateral Articulation Agreement 2025 Graduates Effective June 2025 through December 2026

Purpose of Agreement

This Career-Technical bilateral articulation agreement recognizes a seamless curriculum pathway from high school to an associate degree, certification, or apprenticeship program that will lead to a career in a related technical field. A graduate who successfully completes the four (4) ODEW courses within the secondary program pathway and meets enrollment criteria is eligible to earn college credits for the courses specified in this agreement.

Student Responsibilities

Students seeking college credit through this agreement must

- Complete the secondary program competencies aligned with the Columbus State
 Community College (CSCC) articulated courses with a grade average of C or better.
- Submit an application and subsequently matriculate to the CSCC program identified above no later than 18 months from high school graduation (December 2026 for June 2025 graduates).
- Meet CSCC college entrance requirements and complete the ACCUPLACER or ACT assessment in order for credits to appear on transcript.

Secondary School Responsibilities

Secondary instructors and administrators must

- Complete the *Recommendation for Bilateral Articulated College Credit* form for each student prior to his/her graduation.
- Provide a copy to the student and maintain a file copy. Original copy will go directly to Columbus State Community College.
- Communicate to students and parents the process for obtaining CSCC articulated credit.

Columbus State Community College Responsibilities

Faculty and staff at CSCC must

- Award articulated credit only for those technical courses identified as **Achieved** on the *Recommendation for Articulated College Credit* form.
- Record articulated course credit on the student's college transcript after he/she enrolls in the college.
- Waive tuition and fees for articulated credit.
