Non-Vocational Schools – Student Transfer & Tuition Requests

2420 NON-VOCATIONAL SCHOOLS – STUDENT TRANSFER & TUITION REQUESTS

N.J.A.C. 6A:19-2.3 provides that a district board of education must allow for a student accepted to a vocational school to attend said school at the cost of the Sending District. N.J.S.A. 18A:38-15 provides that, “any Board of Education not furnishing instruction in a particular high school course of study, which any pupil resident in the district and who has completed elementary course of study provided therein may desire to pursue, may, *in its discretion*, pay the tuition of such pupil for instruction in such course of study in a high school of another district”

In order to address requests for student transfers and tuition requests to attend non-vocational schools, the Bayonne Board of Education is adopting this policy.

The Bayonne Board of Education will only provide support stated in N.J.A.C. 6A:19-2.3.
