





Budget Preparation

As we went through this budget process this past couple months, some clear themes emerged:

- The district has experienced significant cuts in programs and staff over the past ten years
- New staff and program recommendations from administration are intended to 'rebuild' programs and services that had been cut in the past
- Social/emotional learning needs for all students is paramount
- Increased focus needs to be placed on intervention supports this will influence referrals for specialized instruction
- At the middle and high school, we need to provide more diverse course offerings and opportunities in order to be more 'competitive' with private schools

Cashman Elementary

• Secretarial Support (School safety): \$26,493

Increase clerk hours

Increase Secretary hours

• Kindergarten Program (intervention and instruction): \$35,000

• Increase paraprofessional hours from 19 to 25 hours

• Increase .5 FTE PreK position to .8 FTE Kindergarten

• English as a Second Language (compliance and instruction): \$15,300

• Increase ELL Teacher from .8 FTE to 1.0 FTE
