Viewpoint School Announces Tennis Legend Pam Shriver as its Class of 2025 Commencement Speaker

CALABASAS, CA – May 14, 2025 – Honoring an enduring tradition of inviting a distinguished speaker to deliver a keynote address to its Upper School graduates, Viewpoint School announced today tennis legend Pam Shriver as its commencement speaker for the Class of 2025. On Saturday, June 7, at 9:30 a.m., Viewpoint will hold its annual Commencement ceremony with 107 graduates surrounded by family, friends, school administrators, faculty, staff, trustees, and alumni.

Known to the world as an American tennis champion, Olympic gold medalist, International Tennis Hall of Famer, and ESPN and Tennis Channel Broadcaster, Pam also is a proud parent of a Viewpoint Alumnus of the Class of 2024 and member of the Board of Trustees.

“Pam Shriver brings a legacy of excellence, discipline, and leadership—values that mirror Viewpoint’s mission to deliver world-ready graduates, who are prepared for lives of purpose and impact,” said Mark McKee, Head of School. “She is an inspiring role model for our students, and we look forward to the powerful insights Pam will share with the Class of 2025.”

“It’s an incredible honor to speak at this year’s graduation ceremony,” said Shriver. “High school is such a pivotal time in life, and I’m excited to share a few lessons from my journey—on and off the court—with these remarkable young people as they step into their next chapter. I hope to inspire them to embrace challenges, lead with integrity, and always keep striving for their personal best.”

Pam made her indelible mark in tennis as one of the greatest doubles players in history. During the 1980s and 1990s, she won 133 WTA Tour-level titles, including 21 singles titles, 111 women's doubles titles, and one mixed doubles title. Pam’s most meaningful non-major championship came in 1988 when she and partner Zina Garrison won the Olympic Gold Medal at the 1988 Games played in Seoul. In 2002, she was inducted into the International Tennis Hall of Fame. Pam later embarked on a highly successful broadcasting career and is currently commentating for ESPN and the Tennis Channel. Her presence at Viewpoint’s Commencement is expected to leave a lasting impression on graduates and their families, imparting a living example of lifelong dedication and service to others. Born on the Fourth of July, Pam is the ideal speaker for this year’s class of Viewpoint Patriots.
