Dear **Crim Family**:

If your household income is less than 185% of the federal poverty level, your student(s) may be eligible for a program called **Summer EBT/SUN Bucks**.

Participating families will receive **\$120 for each eligible child on a card**, that you can use to buy food during the summer at grocery stores, farmers markets, and other authorized retailers.

If you think your children are eligible, you can get **Summer EBT/SUN Bucks** by filling out a simple application. To apply for **Summer EBT/SUN Bucks** go to sebt.ohio.gov/apply/ or scan the QR code below. **APPLY NOW! The deadline to apply is August 15, 2025** in order to get benefits for this summer. You will need to provide your child's name, school, and date of birth, along with the names of the people in your household, your household income, and address where the benefit card should be sent. You will not need to provide any documentation to apply.

If you receive more than \$120 per eligible child in your household, do not use the benefits. Contact The **Summer EBT/SUN Bucks agency contact information** as soon as possible to confirm or correct the error.

In addition to Summer **EBT/SUN Bucks**, the children under 18 years of age in your household can also receive free meals during the summer at a summer meal site. You can call 1-866-3-HUNGRY or 1-877-8-HAMBRE (or text 914-342-7744 with the keyword "summer meals" to find the location closest to you.
