RIGHT TO PROTEST (SC Code § 11-35-4210)

A prospective bidder, offeror, contractor, subcontractor who is aggrieved in connection with this solicitation may be entitled to protest. A protest must be submitted to the Chief Procurement Officer within fifteen (15) days from the date of the issuance of the solicitation documents, or an amendment to it, if the amendment is at issue. Days are calculated as provided in Section 11-35-310(13). Protests must be in writing and must be received by the Chief Procurement Officer within the time provided.

By submitting a protest to the foregoing email address, you (and any person acting on your behalf) consent to receive communications regarding your protest (and any related protests) at the e-mail address from which you sent your protest.

All document requests should be directed to the procuring agency project coordinator. If a protest is pending, the protestant's lawyer may access otherwise unavailable information by applying to the CPO for the issuance of a protective order.
