The City of Portland (City) and its representatives will hold a public meeting on a proposed cleanup project at Fitzpatrick Stadium, located on a portion of the property identified as 165 Park Avenue in Portland, Maine (Site). The proposed cleanup project pertains to contaminated soil that was generated during a construction project associated with improvements and upgrades at the stadium. The City has been awarded a US EPA Brownfields-funded Subgrant through the Greater Portland Council of Governments (GPCOG) that will be used for proper management and off-site disposal of the impacted soils.

A draft Analysis of Brownfields Cleanup Alternatives (ABCA) and Remedial Action Plan (RAP) has been prepared for this project, which is currently being reviewed by the Maine Department of Environmental Protection (MEDEP) and the US EPA as a requirement of the US EPA Brownfields Program. The City and its representatives are providing public notice of the availability of the draft ABCA and RAP for public review and comment during a 30-day public comment period. The public meeting will be held at 5:30 pm on Thursday, May 22, 2025, at the Site (165 Park Avenue, in the Fitzpatrick Stadium parking lot).
