## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

**SUBJECT:** RELEASE OF FY24 SCHOOL AND DISTRICT GRADES

On July 24, the Florida Department of Education (FDOE) released the FY24 School and District Grades. With the second year of the Benchmark for Excellent Student Thinking (B.E.S.T.) standards implementation completed, the full school grade formula including learning gains was used. With this formula applied, the School District of Palm Beach County is rated "A" for FY24.

During the FY23 school year, FDOE transitioned from the Florida Standards Assessments (FSA) to the Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST). The FAST results provide the foundation for school grades based on a grading system adopted by the State Board of Education (SBOE). This grading system uses the percentage of total points earned across several components including achievement, learning gains for all students and for the lowest 25% students, high school graduation rates, as well as acceleration success in middle and high school. As FY23 was the first year of FAST administration, the school grade computation excluded the learning gains components and grades were calculated as informational baseline grades only. The full model was re-implemented in FY24 and added a grade 3 reading performance component for elementary schools. School grades were not released fully in FY20 and FY21 due to the pandemic.<sup>1</sup> Therefore, the present summary includes FY19, FY22, FY23, and FY24 results for comparison. Schools and districts are rated "A" through "F" based on a percentage of points earned. As part of the accountability transition, the SBOE set new thresholds for school grades. Table 1 details the FY24 grading scale.

A review of the FY24 School and District Grades revealed the following:

#### District Grades

- Palm Beach is one of seven Florida school districts to improve their letter grade from FY23 to FY24.
- When compared with all 67 Florida school districts on percent of points earned, Palm Beach was ranked 15<sup>th</sup>, up from 17<sup>th</sup> in FY23.
- Palm Beach was among five of the seven largest Florida districts to earn an “A” grade and tied with Pinellas for second in percent of points earned.
- When compared with all 67 Florida school districts, Palm Beach has the third highest percentage of students making learning gains in ELA and sixth highest learning gains for our lowest quartile students in ELA.

#### School Grades

- For FY24, the results for traditional<sup>2</sup> District schools showed that:
  - 131 schools were rated “A” or “B,” up from 106 schools in 2023.
  - 74% of high schools were rated “A” or “B,” an increase of 14 percent from FY23.
  - 58% of middle schools were rated “A” or “B,” an increase of 4.5 percent from FY23.
  - 68% of elementary schools were rated “A” or “B,” an increase of 15 percent from FY23.
  - The District had the highest percentage of “A” rated middle schools among the seven largest Florida districts and the State.
  - The District had the second highest percentage of “A” rated high schools, following Dade, among the seven largest Florida districts and the State.
  - The District was tied with Orange for the second highest percentage of “A” rated combination schools, among the seven largest Florida districts and the State.
  - 53 Palm Beach schools improved their letter grade.
    - Plumosa School of the Arts improved from a “C” to an “A.” Plumosa School of the Arts has not been an A-rated school since 2012.
    - K.E.C./Canal Point Elementary improved from a “D” to a “B.” K.E.C./Canal Point Elementary has not been B-rated since 2019.
    - Seven other schools improved their letter grade reaching historically high ratings not seen in a decade.
    - 14 Palm Beach schools improved their letter grade to pre-pandemic levels.

Tables 2a-2e contain the numbers and percentages of School Grades for Florida and District operated elementary, middle, high, combination, and charter schools. Tables 3a–3e contain the percentages of letter grades for District operated elementary, middle, high, combination, and charter schools in the seven large urban Florida districts. Table 4 contains District grades for the seven large urban Florida districts.
