

SCHOOL SUPPLIES LIST

LCHS 2025–2026 Junior High (Grades 7–8)



Welcome to Liberty Common Junior High School. We are looking forward to working with your student in the fall and have created a supplies list to help everyone start off well. Teachers strongly recommend individual binders for each class; different colors for the binders will aid with organization. The true “high-school prep” approach involves taking home each class binder whenever there is homework in that class. If preferred, the alternative is to use a homework accordion file. It is also important that students have notecards during the first month so they can practice making flashcards, which is an essential study skill at LCHS. Please note some of the supplies required for core classes may change slightly at the teacher’s discretion at the start of school. This list should help you get the bulk of the supplies for your classes. More details about the binder size and organization requirements for specific classes will be provided at the beginning of school.

Core Classes

Binders (max 11 in. deep, different colors) and Paper/Note-Taking

- 3 - 2 in. three-ring binders
- 3 - 1½ in. three-ring binders
- 2 - 1 in. three-ring binders
- 6 packages binder tab dividers (8/pkg)
- College-ruled lined paper to fill binders (2-3 packages, may need more during the year)
- 1 non-black three-ring binder used for a writing portfolio throughout grades 7-12 (**7th grade and all new-to-Liberty students**)
- 1 package of ¼” square graph paper
- 2 college-ruled composition books/spiral notebooks
- 2-3 packages of lined 3 x 5 notecards (may need more during the year)

Pencil Bag/Supplies

- Pencil bag to hold following items:
- Pencils- wooden/mechanical, extra lead
- Pens (black, blue, red)
- Pencil sharpener
- Highlighters, different colors
- Large eraser
- Package of colored pencils
- Ruler
- Small scissors
- Glue stick
- Scientific calculator TI-30Xa
- Large book covers (3), including 1 jumbo size if student is taking pre-Algebra or Introductory Algebra
- Planner - where the entire week is visible when open, and has enough room to write assignments for 8 classes a day
 - All students will receive a planner for the 2025-2026 school year.
 - You may purchase a LCJHS planner for \$7.00 from the front office.

Course Fees: An academic fee of \$80 (\$50 for student activities and \$30 for academic materials) for all students in grades 7-8 is assessed at the beginning of the school year during the annual online registration process in August.

Miscellaneous

- Access to an internet-capable computer outside of class to do homework
- One subject spiral notebook and Spanish-English Dictionary for Spanish 1
- Personal notebook for English 8
- Graph paper, pens of various colors, metal compass (center-wheel style preferred), and protractor for Geometry
