- Learning judo techniques
- Fun games, treks and treasure hunts
- Artistic activities: coloring, origami, calligraphy and more
- Judo: an individual and team discipline: learn to share, to be motivated, to have the will, to improve physical and mental performance
- Discovery of Japanese traditions: trains, food, music and gardens.
- Travel virtually to French-speaking and non-French-speaking countries to discover the practice of judo by children from all over the world.

Refunds and Cancellations

If you enroll in camp and can not attend for whatever reason, you may receive a full refund/credit for camp fees, less a registration fee of \$50. Program change/cancellation request must be received 2 weeks prior to the enrolled camp week start date. If you decide to cancel less than 2 weeks prior to the start of the enrolled camp week, you may be granted a 50% refund, less registration fees of \$50. No refunds will be granted 5 days before the start of the camp week.

Participants who do not attend their registered camp week, or do not contact us at least two weeks prior to the camp start date, will not receive a refund or a credit.

Group Requests

We understand that sometime families register for camps to keep their friendships alive throughout the summer months. We believe in cultivating friendships and encouraging healthy interactions amongst all campers. However, we will not be able to accommodate group requests. This will allow us to continue to foster our mission of providing a welcoming environment where all campers feel comfortable growing and learning in our programs.
