**1. Enrollment Process for 2025-26**

- For schools currently using the online screening and reporting platform through the Ottawa Area ISD, it is important to know that educators will not be able to sign into the screening and reporting website until new enrollment information for the 2025-26 school year is processed.
- When your district technology representative is ready to have the OAISD process their 2025-26 district enrollments, please complete the “**2025-2026 District Enrollments**” form, located on the [Contact Us](#) page.
  - Contacts will be notified with their enrollment status after their enrollment information is processed.
- Please coordinate with your district’s technology representative to complete the following steps.
  - Verify that your district’s student information system has been changed over to the new school year.
    - For MI school districts using the MIDataHub, verify that the MIDataHub Delta Math Integration is receiving course enrollment information for the upcoming school year.
    - For school districts sending enrollment files, prepare the first set of enrollment files for the upcoming school year.
  - Transfer the **MIDataHub key and secret** or **enrollment files** to the OAISD SFTP folder for your district.

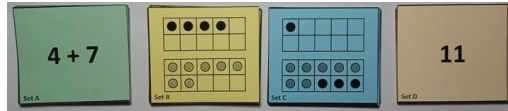
**2. Data Availability after June 14, 2025**

- Data collected before June 14, 2025 will be available in the “[Additional Reports](#)” linked near the bottom of the page at [www.deltamath.org](http://www.deltamath.org). Each district is assigned a common username and password to access student results going back to the 2019-20 school year.
- We are excited to share that updates to the [Data Wall report](#) will allow each district to display Spring Screening-up Data from this school year with the Fall Readiness Screening for the next school year.

**3. Summer School Implementation**

- If you would like to use the Delta Math RtI Program online readiness screeners during the summer, please complete the form “[Register for Summer School](#)”.
- Implementation leaders need to communicate with Joe McKenzie their district’s plan to provide new enrollment files to the Ottawa Area ISD.

- The [Summer Implementation Guide](#) for 2025 includes 5 sets of planning guides with unique scope and sequences. It also includes links to warm-ups, tier 3 intervention lessons, and Delta Math activities.
- It is important to know that summer planning guides link to **Delta Math tier 3 intervention lessons**. Tier 3 intervention lessons are recommended for summer support for two reasons:
  - Time is limited during summer programming and tier 3 lessons build the math using manipulatives during session 1, rather than re-engaging students with the guided reviews provided in tier 2 lessons.
  - Summer implementation support is simplified for educators not familiar with the re-engagement session in the tier 2 intervention lessons.
  - **Visual fluency cards** and **independent practice cards** can be purchased on the “[Intervention Kits](#)” tab to save educator’s preparation time for implementing the free Delta Math activities.



#### 4. Implementation Support for New Educators

- To support new educators who are planning to implement Delta Math RtI Program resources next school year, we provide access to the recording of a past implementation training on Zoom.
- This [2.5 hour video](#) has been edited into smaller sections to provide more flexibility and efficiency while learning about each implementation topic.
- Each topic addresses one of the following professional learning questions:
  - What should students know and be able to do?
  - How will we know if students have unfinished learning?
  - How can we help students complete unfinished learning?
