## 5. **Academy of Driving Presentation from Josh Acre** **Processes, timing, all the DMV secrets to making it easier for your soon-to-be driver.**

- Online Driver's Ed, "Certified CA Drivers Ed Program" to get the "Pink Slip"
- Before going to the DMV, fill out the application online
  - In order to get the Real ID at the same time of Permit, bring two proofs of Residency and two forms of ID
- Computer test - can only skip 3 questions
  - can request a written test
  - or request an appointment for a "face to face" test - better for those with dyslexia
- Then receive the Permit
  - the permit is NOT official until signed by a CA driving instructor
  - Your car insurance covers permit drivers
- 6 months, 50 logged hours with parent - 6 hours with driving school, 10 hours of night driving
- AoD's 1st class is 75 minutes. New drivers will learn how to drive on neighborhoods, surface streets, highways, and have a "mock test" - to serve as practice before the actual test for 1 hour and then take the student to the test site.
- AoD - donates to the RHS Parent's Club, as Joshua is an RHS Alumni.
- Considerations for Insurance
  - 3.0+ GPA Good Student Discount
  - Part-time driver vs Full-time driver

- Other notes:
  - written note from parent giving permission to drive a sibling in the house for 1st year driver
  - 11pm-5am Restricted driving/curfew, until age of 18. Written note from young driver's boss if returning home from work.
  - no phones
- Safety Class - CHP "Start Smart" - check with insurance specifically
- If you have multiple vehicles at home - the older vehicle, the cheaper the insurance
- App: "Road Ready" - free app to track driving hours; able to print out
  - DMV may need to see driving log
- Insurance automatically covers permit drivers. Licensed drivers must have insurance.
