1	Have you conducted a shadow study to determine how the project would affect the amount of sunlight that adjacent properties receive throughout the year?	We are in the process of developing a shadow study. Results will be available before we finalize our submission to the BZA.
2	How long will the project take from breaking ground to completion?	We anticipate that the project will be completed within 18-24 months of breaking ground (targeting completion for fall 2028)
3	Will the building remain occupied during construction?	Students will remain in our current building during construction of the new addition. Upgrades to the historic building (HVAC, plumbing, and electrical) will be timed to occur while students are on breaks (summer, spring, winter, and on faculty professional development days).
4	What is the plan for contractor parking?	No contractors will be permitted to park on the neighborhood streets. This and other related issues will be addressed in a construction management plan that is currently under development and will be shared prior to the BZA hearing.
5	How will pick-up and drop-off change as a result of the project?	There will be no change to pick up and drop off as a result of the new addition.
