#### Dear Parents,

Tomorrow is a **regular day for 5th and 6th graders**. If your student is in **7th grade**, they will come to school as normal and then be bussed over to the Sugar Land Methodist Church in order to attend 8th grade celebration. 7th graders will then return to campus for a day of community building and leadership training as they "Step-up" into 8th grade. Please make sure that your permission slip has been turned into Ms. Scheffer. 8th graders will go directly to the church for Celebration. They are asked to dress in their "Sunday Best" for the event. # Middle School Drop-Off

Students may be dropped off beginning at 7:15 a.m. (If you need to drop your child off earlier, please sign them up for the Extended Care Program.) Students arriving after 7:15 a.m. will go directly to the cafeteria and will be dismissed at 7:30 a.m. to go to their lockers and then to their first period class. All students should be dropped off in the front car line area. There will be staff outside directing traffic and welcoming students.

Students are not allowed to go upstairs until 7:30 A. M.

VERY IMPORTANT: To help the flow of traffic for FBCA, as well as surrounding companies/businesses, parents must approach our campus during morning drop off and afternoon pickup from Jess Pirtle as follows:

- Take Hwy. 90 to Eldridge
- Head north on Eldridge to Jess Pirtle
- Turn right on Jess Pirtle
- Turn right on Gillingham
- Turn right on Lakeview until you reach our parking lot.

<u>Left turns from Lakeview to enter the parking lot are prohibited during morning and afternoon carpool times</u>. From approximately 7:25 a.m. - 7:55 a.m., one of our SLPD officers will be directing a lane closure on Gillingham prohibiting turning left onto Lakeview.

Please note: in order for Faculty & Staff to have access in a timely manner to the parking lot, Faculty & Staff will be able to make a left turn into the staff parking lot coming from Eldridge on Lakeview.

# Middle School Afternoon Pick-Up (Middle School Students only)

Students should report immediately after the 3:05 p.m. dismissal to the front of the school. Pick up will be made in one of two lines. Students with the last name beginning with the alphabet

A-M is picked up in the lane closest to the school.

N - Z is picked up outside lane between the 1st and 2nd row of parked cars

There is staff outside assisting students to their cars. Please make sure you have your car tag visible.

## Middle School Afternoon Pick Up (Upper, Middle and Lower School Students)

Students of carpools that also include upper school and/or lower school students report to the area outside the front doors and wait for the lower school carpool to begin at 3:15 p.m.

Upper school carpool begins at 3:30 p.m.

Any student not picked up by 3:45 p.m. goes to the Extended Care Program and regular extended care fees are billed to the parent's account.

No middle school student is allowed to leave campus from the upper school.

#### Lunch

"A" lunch for 5th and 6th grade students is from 12:10 p.m. to 12:45 p.m. on regular days and 12:00 p.m. - 12:35 p.m. on Chapel days.

"B" lunch for 7th and 8th grade students is from 1:00 p.m. - 1:35 p.m. on regular days and 12:50 p.m. - 1:25 p.m. on Chapel days.

You are always welcome to come and join your child for lunch.

We do not allow DoorDash deliveries for students.

# **Technology**

All Middle School students are issued an iPad for their school use. Students may use their own device at home; however while on campus, they will be required to use the school issued IPAD only.

5th grade students do not take IPADS home.

6th, 7th and 8th grade students are responsible for bringing their IPADS to and from home, as well as making sure they are fully charged each day.

The office will no longer issue students a loaner IPAD in the event they leave theirs at home.

#### New Password Self-Service for Middle School

Starting December 14, Middle School students will have access to password self-service, similar to Upper School students. However, parents must assist with the process. This feature will allow students to update their Google Workspace and WiFi passwords. A parent's mobile phone number must be on file to enable password changes, and this requirement has already been met for all 7th and 8th graders.

Families of Middle School students are encouraged to <u>watch this instructional video</u> for guidance on using the password reset self-service feature. You can access the link to reset your students password through these platforms - logging into Classlink and clicking password reset, the **Parent Zone** or the **MyFBCA Resource Board**.
