We invite students and parents to register your own HERO account so we may keep the lines of communication between home and school open.


Students and Parents/Guardians will each have a unique Hero login account.

2) Click on your user type






3) Click on “CREATE AN ACCOUNT”


 **Hero Student Access**



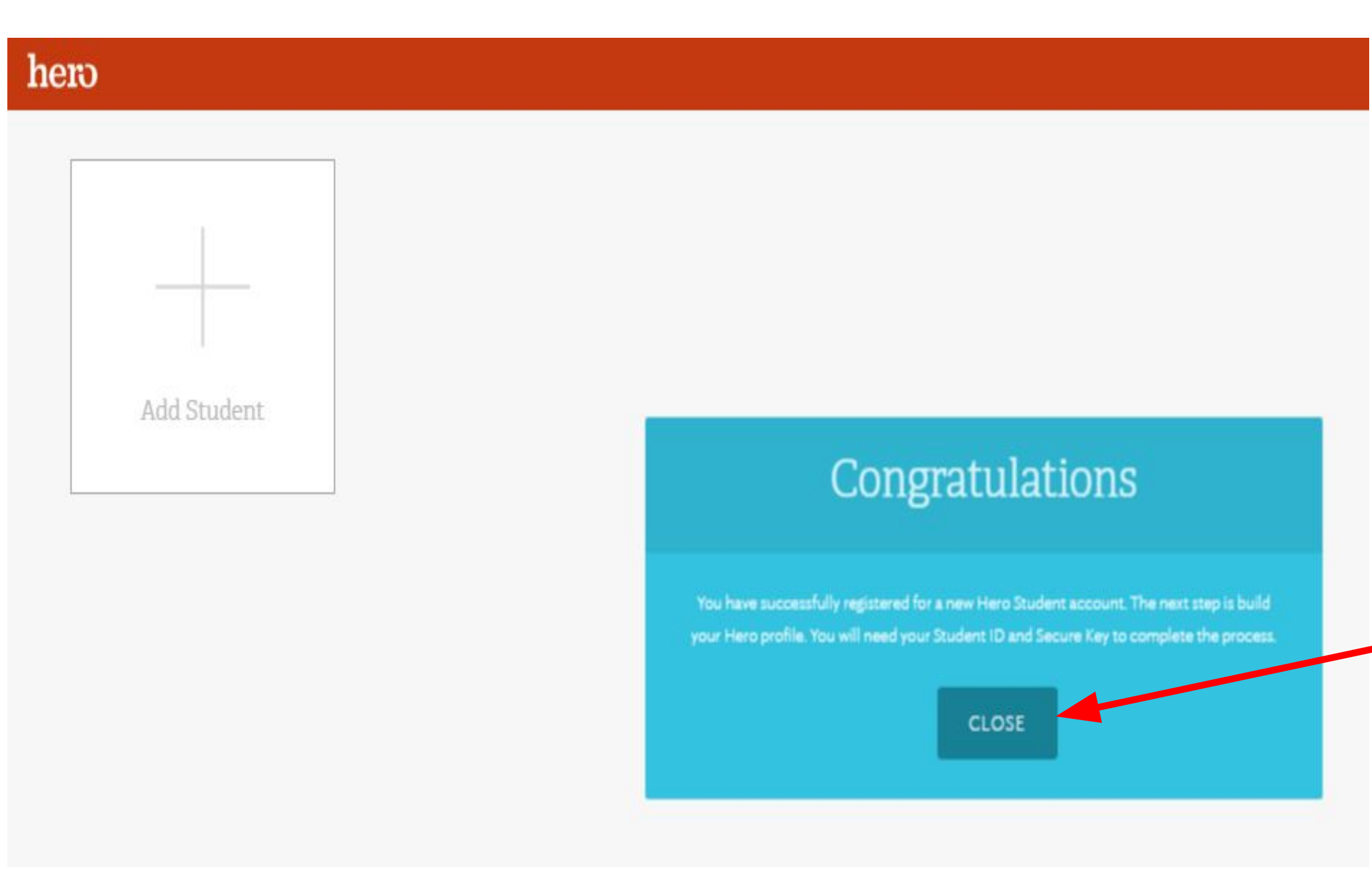

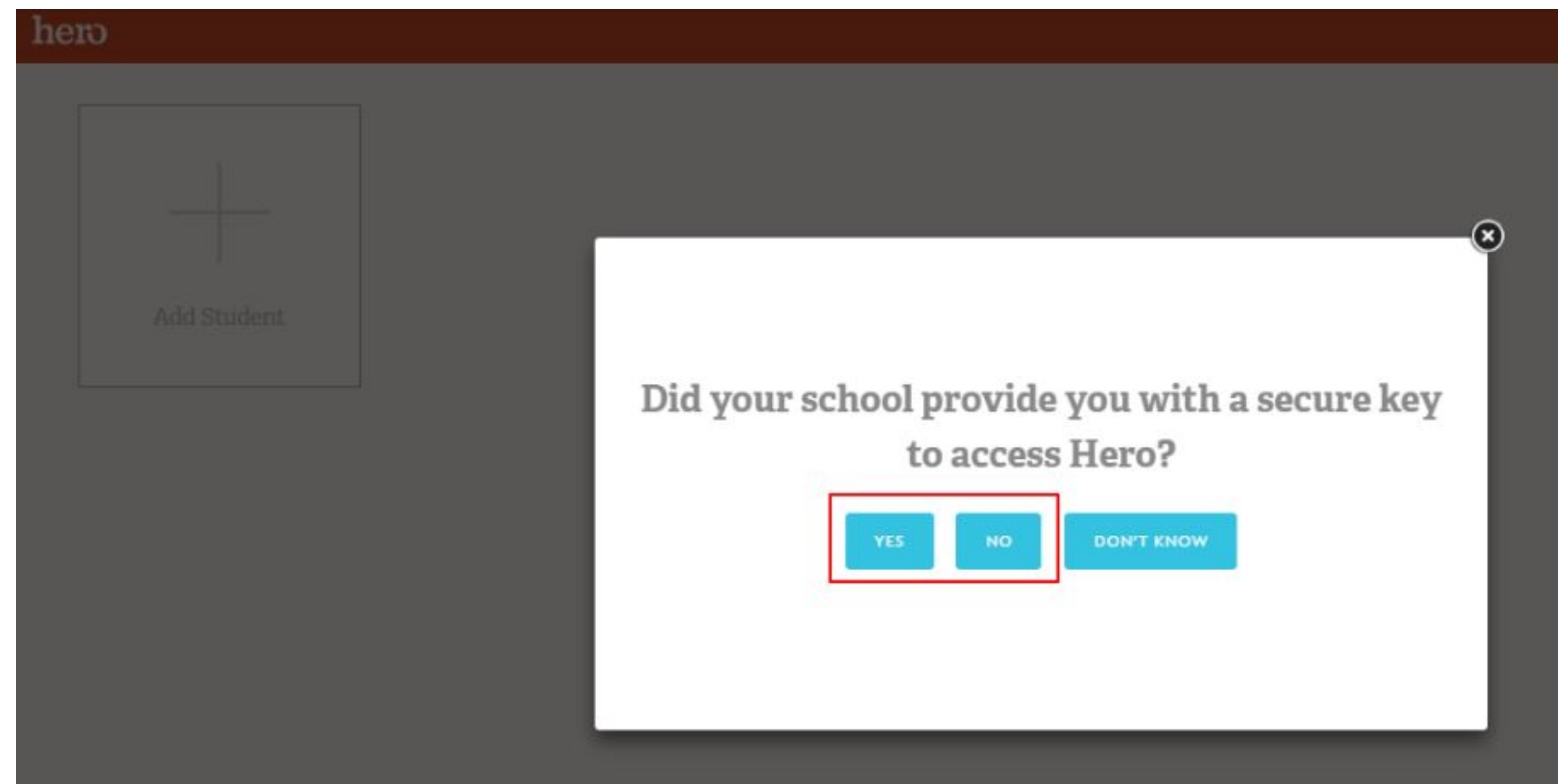
9) Click on the “+” sign to associate this account with your student data in Hero

10) Did the school give you a specific *activation key*? If so, click YES.


11) If not, click NO and you will still be able to get things set up.

- c) Click “ADD STUDENT”



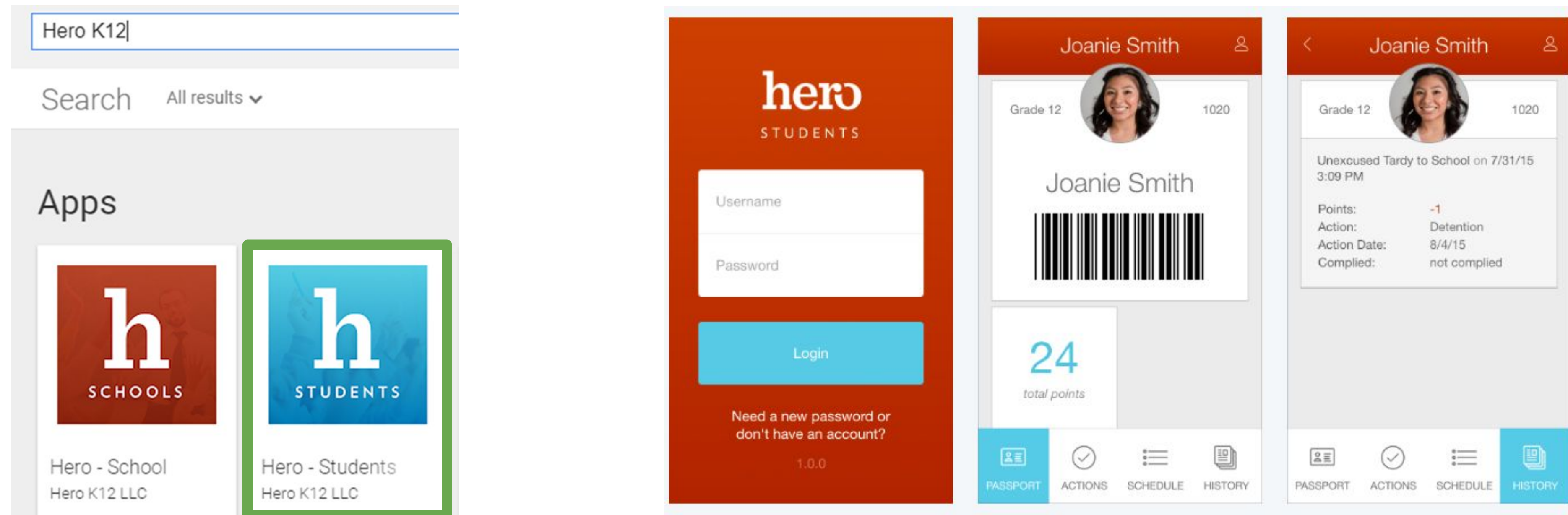
