

Cow-abunga! Come spend story time singing and dancing with Baby Cow (courtesy of Chick-fil-A)! **For toddlers and preschoolers.**




PAWS TO READ Saturday, June 14th, at 11am Saturday, July 12th, at 11am

SUMMER CHALLENGES

Registration begins online at 12:01 AM on *June 2nd*. Go to the links on our website at <u>avonlibrary.net</u> to register. The table below will help you pick what reading clubs are best for your family.

Click 'register' and fill out the form. Please include an email address and/or phone number so we can contact you if you win a prize. Both adult and children's summer reading this year will be completely done through Beanstack - you will not need to register for any other platforms, nor is there a paper log to fill out.

Each participant can only sign up for <u>ONE</u> summer reading club! However, a whole family can participate with every member in a different club. We encourage you to choose the reading club that is closest to your skill level.

CHALLENGES

Logging your reading and completing challenges begins *June 2nd* at 12:01 AM and ends on *July 25th* at 11:59 PM. You must complete all challenges by this time - no exceptions! Please count only what you read from *June 2nd* to *July 25th*. Check out the clubs below to find the challenge best for you!

PRIZE PICKUP

Children's first through fourth level prizes, challenge prizes, Library Bucks and registration prizes will be given out as earned or you may wait until the end of the program to pick them all up at once (however, we may run out before then!). Badges earned are virtual, not physical prizes. All prizes are as supplies last and there may *or may not* be substitutes (so it is best to pick up your prizes early!). All prizes must be picked up by *August 1st*. Raffles for adult readers will be drawn weekly.

Reading Club	Best for	Prize/Interval			
Crayons	Babies through those entering 1st grade; picture book readers; and children who are not yet reading but listen to books read to them. Must be 17 or under.	4 levels of prizes at 20, 30, 40, and 50 books logged. Prizes of stickers, candy, books and more!			
Watercolors	Kids entering 2nd and 3rd grade; any child who reads on their own or who listens to books read to them; pre-chapter book readers. Must be 17 or under.	4 levels of prizes at 3, 6, 9, and 12 hours of reading logged. Prizes of stickers, candy, books and more!			
Pastels	Those going into 3rd or 4th grade; kids who read on their own; intermediate to full chapter book readers. Must be 17 or under.	4 levels of prizes at 5, 10, 15, and 20 hours of reading logged. Prizes of stickers, candy, books and more!			
Club 512	Chapter book readers; available to those entering grades 5-12 only .	20 library bucks earned for every 5 hours of reading, up to 40 hours. Use these at the end-of- summer auction!			
Visionaries	High schoolers and adults; teen and adult chapter book readers.	Earn a coupon for the Friends of the Library booksale just for registering! Read 500 minutes to be entered for weekly raffles and to pick 2 prizes!

HOW TO EARN LIBRARY BUCKS

By reading: Starting *June 2nd*, sign up on Beanstack for Club 512, read and log how long you've read. You will earn 20 Library Bucks for every 5 hours of reading.

Participate in a program: You can receive 10 Library Bucks for attending an in-person event. **You must register to attend an in-person program. Registration opens 2 weeks prior to programs.**

HOW TO SPEND LIBRARY BUCKS

Tweens and teens are invited to bid on items at our auction, *Tuesday, July 29th, at 5 PM*. **Registration is required.** We will have tickets to museums & attractions, sports memorabilia, games, gift cards, LEGO sets, posters, books, candy, and more to bid on!

BUT THE LIBRARY BUCKS DON'T STOP THERE!

In addition to the Club 512 Summer Reading Challenge, you can also sign up for 100 Books Before Graduation! Read and log reviews for 100 books between the end of 4th grade and when you graduate high school, and earn Library Bucks along the way! You can count books you've read for Summer Reading across both challenges.
Make sure to look at the activity badges - there are categories you have to complete. Don't forget to log your reviews, too!
