The Family Life Code includes a provision for excusing a student from any portion of the program.

"Any pupil whose parent or guardian presents to the school principal a signed statement that any part of the instruction in Family Life Education is in conflict with his/her conscience or sincerely held moral or religious beliefs, shall be excused from that portion of the course where such instruction is being given and no penalties as to credit or graduation shall result there from."

Healthy Digital Media Use Tips for Families

- Do not feel pressured to introduce technology early.
- Place consistent limits on hours of media use as well as types of media used.
- Excessive media use by parents can decrease communication and interaction with children, and may affect the parent child relationship.
- Have "media-free" times like mealtime and bedtime.
- Discourage entertainment media while doing homework.
- Check your children's media use for their health and safety.
- Take "eye" breaks.
 Optometrists recommend looking away from the computer every 20 minutes for 20 seconds at an object 20 feet away.
- Engage in family activities that promote well-being, such as sports, reading, and talking with each other.
- Talk with your children about online citizenship and safety.
- Use sites like "Common Sense Media" to help you decide if movies, TV shows and video games are age and content appropriate for your family values.


