


April Recap



 send in plastic water bottles with a screw off small plastic top-as the tops are
 choking hazards for preschool aged children. (we like to take "water breaks" after
 coming inside from our climber, the water bottles are a huge help-thank you!)
- Please continue to wear secure (laced or velcro) sneakers preferably with socks for outdoor play. If your preschooler wants to wear special shoes to school, sneakers/socks can be sent in, in backpacks for outdoor "safe feet" we will assist them in changinging shoes.
- Our final two days of preschool will be Tuesday, June 3rd and Wednesday, June 4th. Both days will be full days of preschool (depending on your child's regular schedule) snack and lunch will be served-we will have resting time for full day students. We will celebrate with the children in school and they will be dismissed at their regular dismissal time with some special items. (please let us know if your child will be absent on either of those days and we will be sure to send home their materials, and any belongings the week before.) (if anything is left behind, we will still be in the building Thursday, June 5th)
