WHEREAS: The Board of Education, in order to reduce costs and at the same time maintain the highest possible educational standards, has implemented an Employee Severance Plan™ which was presented to and approved by the Board of Education on March 10, 2025, and

WHEREAS: The ESP – Employee Severance Plan™ document Exhibit A, (attached) states "The District in its sole discretion reserves the right to retain certain Eligible Employees who elect to participate in the Plan for up to one (1) year beyond the Exit Date, based on operational and educational needs of the District. Those retained will still receive the same ESP benefit dollar amount based on his/her resignation or retirement or separation from District service date, and the ESP benefits will commence four (4) months following his/her actual exit date."
