6. Major Exposure Reduction Activities

Salem Keizer Public Schools has attached a comprehensive summary of major activities completed that resulted in reduced risk of exposure to hazardous materials.

Radon exposure: All nine schools with radon mitigation systems have been retested as a periodic check to ensure that the radon mitigation measures are working. These schools will be retested every 5 years per OHA recommendations. Major renovations are currently underway at three non-school locations; these locations will be re-tested following completion of renovations. One school is scheduled for major renovations during the first part of the 2025-26 school year; radon retesting will be completed in the winter of 2026 at this school.

Lead in water: Elevated levels of lead in water were found in one fixture at each of these schools: Fruitland Elementary, Crossler Middle School, and Walker Middle School. All fixtures were replaced and retesting resulted in non-elevated lead levels for all fixtures.
