See everything you've read, share reading with friends, and keep your daily reading streak alive. Get motivated to meet your reading goals with new reading challenges and virtual badges. Go to bit.ly/GCSReads30 (case sensitive) and click on the Clever link to begin logging your summer reading minutes.

THERE'S AN APP FOR THAT!

To use Beanstack on a personal phone or tablet, download the Beanstack app. Once you're in the app, choose "At my library, school, or bookstore," and then search for Jones Elementary but make sure the 2nd page says Guilford County Schools. Sign in via Clever and start logging minutes (Username is studentid#@stu.gcsnc.com and Password is birthday MMDDYYYY)!
