RCS Summer Learning Program

Rochester Community Schools' Summer Learning Program information is now available online on the RCS District Website. Courses offered for middle school students include:

- Middle School Health (non-credit), optional for students who will be in 8th grade next year and did not take Health/PE during the 7th grade year
- Algebra Prep (non-credit), for students currently in Pre-Algebra who may need to strengthen their math skills before taking Algebra next year (this is not a credit-earning class, but a skill-building class)
- CSI Science (non-credit), for students going into 8th or 9th grade next year
- MS Math Summer Program (non-credit), for reviewing key math concepts and building confidence
- Summer Music Theater (non-credit)
- Summer Innovation camp (non-credit)
- High School Physical Education (.5 credit), for incoming 9th graders only
- High School Health (.5 credit), for incoming 9th graders only
- High School World History Semester 1 (.5 credit) and Semester 2 (.5 credit), for incoming 9th graders only. Please note that BOTH the Semester 1 AND the Semester 2 courses are needed to fulfill graduation requirement.



Attendance Procedure

Please notify the school before **12:00 PM** of any student absences. There are 2 options to report any absence, or to request a late arrival or early dismissal:

Online in your ParentVue Account by pressing "Report Absence" next to your student's name. You may enter absences until 12:00 noon for the current day, and up to one week in advance. The default is the current day, so please ensure you've selected the correct day(s). For early dismissal/late arrival, please add in the Note section the time of the early dismissal or late arrival. Remember to press SAVE once you have entered all information!

Telephone by calling the VH attendance line at **248-726-4910** and following the prompts for either all-day or part day absences.

Students leaving early will be sent a pass from the office, and should come to the main office at the designated time. They will wait in the office until the parent/guardian arrives in the lobby and signs them out.
