During her report, President Davidson highlighted the recent Career and Technical Education (CTE) Advisory Committee meeting, showcasing the district's diverse CTE programs. She noted guest speakers from fields such as medical, engineering, and robotics, as well as opportunities for job shadowing, dual enrollment, and workplace readiness workshops. She emphasized the many pathways available to students on campus, including the OCDE Ambassador Program, where three ambassadors represent our district and provide feedback on CTE. President Davidson also highlighted that Los Alamitos High School experienced the highest growth rate in CTE participation across the county—the largest increase among all high schools.
