Synchronous learning is online or distance education that happens in real time.

Asynchronous learning occurs through online channels without real-time interaction.

Students who receive remote instruction will be engaged in synchronous instruction, asynchronous instruction, or a combination of these two. In this unprecedented time, remote instruction will allow our teachers to deliver quality instruction to all students. For remote instruction to be effective, it is critical that students and families understand the following expectations and etiquette as you are invited to participate in the classrooms.

1. Dedicate a quiet space for remote instruction. Distractions will decrease engagement and understanding.
2. Students will see and be seen while participating in their classroom activities. Please ensure students are dressed appropriately.
3. Respect the privacy rights of all students. Students are protected by the Family Educational Rights to Privacy Act, (FERPA). During remote instruction, students and family members must understand and comply with student privacy rights.
