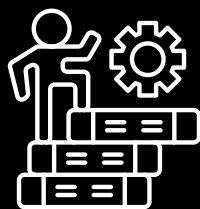

**KHS Seniors Jae Gandy and Kendall Bever** were awarded top of the class for their vocational programs at New Castle Career Center!

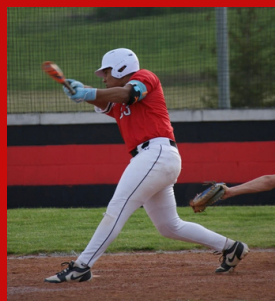

Below you will find the final exam schedule which affects our release times for Thursday and Friday (May 29 & 30). Please read the following information closely so that you fully understand the changes and expectations. **These changes apply to Knightstown High School only.**

- **On Thursday**, we will follow the following schedule with an early release time of 11:30am:

Period 5 (Announcements)	8:10-9:15
Period 6	9:20-10:20
Period 7	10:25-11:30
Lunch	11:30-12:00*

**\*Lunch is available to any student who wants to stay and eat at school.**  
Students who do not have a ride home will stay at school until 3:05 as usual.

- **On Friday**, we will follow the following schedule with an early release time of 1:30pm:

Period 1 (Announcements)	8:10-9:15
Period 2	9:20-10:20
Period 4 (LUNCH)	10:25-11:50
Period 3	11:55-1:00
Senior Walk	1:00-1:15
Dismissal	1:15

Students who do not have a ride home will stay at school until 3:05 as usual.

- ❖ KHS must be notified if you are picking up your student at the early release times. Any student who does not have permission to drive home or be picked up early will remain in the media center until our normal release time (3:05pm) and will then ride the bus home or be picked up as usual.
- ❖ On Wednesday, lunch will be offered in the cafeteria from 11:30-12:00 pm if students would like to eat prior to leaving. If your student is staying to eat lunch, we must still be notified that the student will be picked up at 12:00pm.
- ❖ AM vocational students will attend KHS on Thursday in order to complete their final exams.
- ❖ PM vocational students will be slightly late to vocational on Friday after completing final exams. Senior vocational students will not report on this day.
- ❖ The New Castle Career Center is aware of our Final Exam Schedule although vocational students are still encouraged to communicate with their NCCC instructors.
- ❖ Students are expected to attend all final exam periods unless KHS receives a call from the parent/guardian.
- ❖ Students must take all final exams and/or complete all end-of-semester projects, and must remain in the classroom until the bell rings for the end of the period.
- ❖ The make-up date for final exams missed is Monday, June 2. Students who miss exams are expected to come to KHS to complete their final exams or make arrangements to take them early.
