




Taking Care of Young Children's Teeth—Part 2

(One Year through Five Years)

- Find out if the running water in your area has fluoride in it. If it doesn't, ask your child's health provider about fluoride supplements and start them around six months of age. Fluoride helps strengthen your baby's teeth.
- Provide a diet low in sugar-rich foods.
- Discourage thumb sucking that lasts beyond a child's fourth year. Praise a child of positive behavior when he/she is not sucking his/her thumb.
- A first dental visit is recommended for preventative advice. Some dentists don't see a child until age 3 unless there are problems or concerns.
- Prepare your child for the upcoming visit in a calm, positive way. If you are afraid of the dentist, don't let your child know that. A lot of dental fear begins in early childhood and can be avoided.
