C-1: Information and Presentation on the Behavior Supports Work Plan

Zhanna Preston, Executive Director of Special Education and Mary Walters, Director of Student Support presented an update on the District's Behavior Supports Work Plan which includes developing and implementing School Wide Positive Behavioral Intervention Supports (SWPBIS) district wide and a three-tiered model of behavior interventions that proactively teaches positive behavior, identifies at-risk students, and offers effective interventions so that positive student behavior can support academic success.

They reported that the response from school sites has been overwhelmingly positive. High schools and middle schools are working together to align and standardize the discipline matrix for consistency district wide, and elementary schools are developing common ways to track student behavior data. They indicated that the next step will be to increase training in the spring to include parents, classified staff and community members.
