Kassen Klein, community member and parent, thanked Dr. Stan Scheer for his extraordinary leadership and for his friendship.

Principal Renate Jefferson introduced **Holland Fox**, as the new ASB Student Representative to the Board. Holland highlighted student activities and upcoming events at Murrieta Valley High School.

Principal Darren Daniel introduced **Peyton Lyon**, as the new ASB Student Representative to the Board. Peyton highlighted student activities and upcoming events at Vista Murrieta High School.

Principal Mary Walters introduced **Delaney Noll**, as the new ASB Student Representatives to the Board. Delaney highlighted student activities and upcoming events at Murrieta Mesa High School.

**Employee Organization Communications**

Kathy Ericson, President of the Murrieta Teachers Association reported that this year started with a large increase in student enrollment over what was projected, and in spite of the State's situation morale is up, kids are excited and motivated. She indicated that a large part of this has been due to Dr. Scheer's leadership. Ms. Ericson stated that our district is united and moving forward with incredible staff to keep it in full motion.

**Superintendent Communications**

Superintendent Scheer announced that he has accepted a position with the Thompson School District in Loveland, Colorado to be closer to family, and will be leaving the Murrieta Valley Unified School District on September 30, 2012. He read aloud his letter of resignation.

President Diffley accepted Dr. Scheer's resignation on behalf of the Board.

**Board Communications**

Trustee Robin Crist shared her notes during the Board's initial interview meetings with Dr. Scheer in which he shared his vision for the district that included many programs that came to fruition under his leadership. She stated that he is a great leader and personal friend. She expressed her gratitude for the time and personal sacrifice he gave to the students and staff of the district, and remarked that she is pleased that he would be closer to family in Colorado.

Trustee Kris Thomasian stated because of Dr. Scheer's tremendous leadership and guidance he turned a very good district into an absolute great district. She thanked him for keeping the Board focused and moving in the same direction, and indicated that while he will be missed, his legacy will live on.

Trustee Margi Wray shared that when they visited with Dr. Scheer's staff from Littleton, Colorado prior being hired, everyone lamented his leaving. She stated that in addition to gaining an amazing leader, she gained an amazing friend. She noted that Dr. Scheer has changed the culture of this district and has done this by example. The hours he has given selflessly to support students and staff. She noted that when he came to Murrieta he promised five years and every day thereafter was a gift. Ms. Wray thanked him for leaving the district strong.

Trustee Ken Dickson quoted a poem which states "life changes everything, life must go on, we cannot stand in its way." He thanked Dr. Scheer for his vision, dedication and sacrifice. He indicated that the quality of one's life is with the quality of one's relationships. He thanked Dr. Scheer for lifting everyone and wished him luck and Godspeed.

Trustee Paul Diffley remarked that it's not many superintendents that would pick up their trombone and play with a middle school band. He acknowledged Dr. Scheer's wife, Marian, for her support and allowing him to devote many hours to the district. Mr. Diffley shared a story of Camille Cruz, a student in Farmington, New Mexico whose hopes for joining her middle school orchestra were crushed because she wanted to use a purple violin that was a gift from her grandmother. He said that Dr. Scheer would never have let this happen for he always placed the care for students as his top priority.

Mr. Diffley acknowledged County Superintendent of Schools, Kenn Young, for attend the meeting.
