Freddie Musquiz, Acting President of the Murrieta Chapter of the California School Employees Association (CSEA) was pleased to report that all is going well.

Kathy Ericson, President of the Murrieta Teachers Association (MTA) reported visiting each school site, observed wonderful activities and interventions, and was pleased to see kids excited. She said that it was a great start to the school year.

## **Superintendent Communications**

Superintendent Scheer reported that the energy is incredible at all schools. He noted that the district will continue to make technology a priority, especially with the advent of the iPad which levels the playing field for teachers and inspires students to learn. He noted that he especially appreciates the cooperation with MTA and CSEA. He reported participating in a panel that interviewed students in Mr. Levin's Virtual Enterprise class at Murrieta Valley High School. He was impressed by the students' depth of knowledge and enthusiasm. He said that the facility facelift at Murrieta Valley High School is marvelous and thanked staff for making it look seamless. Dr. Scheer reminded everyone that Murrieta Mesa High School will be graduating their first senior class this school year and he looks forward to attending all three comprehensive high school graduations.

## **Board Communications**

Trustee Margi Wray thanked staff for the revving up that has to happen to get schools off to a great start. She was pleased with the high level of enthusiasm and number of activities going on, and credited principals for effectively juggling their responsibilities and for leading students.

Trustee Kris Thomasian also acknowledged staff for the many positive things going on in schools and for maintaining focus despite budget issues. She referred to the comprehensive list of Adult Education classes offered to students and community members, adding that they provide a wonderful opportunity for exposure to our campuses and their offerings.

Trustee Ken Dickson remarked that it is rejuvenating to see the excitement in students and staff this time of year. He mentioned that we are coming up to the threshold of the ten-year remembrance of 9/11, and while it is a challenging world, it's definitely in contrast to the freshness and positive educational experience that this district has maintained with Dr. Scheer's leadership.

Trustee Robin Crist attended a powerful presentation on cyberbullying at Shivela Middle School. She thanked the middle school staff and parent groups for allowing students to participate. She also expressed her appreciation to District Nurse, Cathy Owens and all school nurses for implementing the TDAP immunization program. Ms. Crist distributed the Riverside County School Boards Association's calendar of events and roster of delegates. She announced that this year's joint meeting with San Bernardino County School Boards Association is scheduled for October 24, 2011 at the San Bernardino Hilton.

Trustee Paul Diffley stated that he is very pleased with the continued increase in our student academic scores and student involvement. He emphasized that a clean campus sets the stage for a positive educational experience, and expressed his appreciation to the maintenance staff for their hard work and attention to detail. He indicated that staff coming together: principals, excited activities directors, classified and certificated staff, make for a great educational system and credited Superintendent Scheer for his vision. In closing Mr. Diffley remarked that it's really good to recognize that we're "getting better all the time."
