**REGULAR MEETING MINUTES  
May 13, 2010**

**Presentations & Recognitions**

MVHS Robotics Club

Superintendent Scheer congratulated MVHS teacher Kevin Bradley and his students on the success of the Robotics class and club. The Robotics teams have been successful at numerous competitions including the 2009 National Competition in Omaha and the 2010 World Championships Tournament in Dallas, Texas.

MVHS Virtual Enterprise

Superintendent Scheer recognized MVHS teacher Joel Levin on the Virtual Enterprise program. Students gave a presentation about RetroSpecs, a Virtual Enterprise company.

MVHS Basketball Team

Superintendent Scheer congratulated the MVHS Nighthawk Baseball Team and their coaches on a winning season. The Nighthawks became the first team from Southwest Riverside County to win a CIF basketball section title. In addition, Coach Tarabilda was named the High School Gametime Coach of the Year.

Public comment was received from Judi Rightmire, MVHS Library Technician asking the Board to consider moving non-student days for Spring Break to coincide with surrounding school districts.

Student ASB Representative, Rosielle Abille, highlighted student activities and upcoming events at Vista Murrieta High School.

Superintendent Scheer and President Crist presented Student ASB Representatives with a Certificate of Appreciation and a high school sweatshirt for serving as Student ASB Representatives to the Board this past school year.

**Employee Organization Communications**

Chuck Smith, President of the Murrieta Teachers Association remarked that yesterday's retirement event was amazing and uplifting. He reported attending the "Sound of Music" musical at Murrieta Mesa High School and said that it was a fantastic performance.

It was noted that Craig Frame, President of the California School Employees Association (CSEA) Murrieta Chapter 223 was absent.

**Superintendent Communications**

Superintendent Scheer reported attending both MVHS and VMHS proms and expressed his appreciation to staff for making these events memorable. He indicated that the Governor will be announcing the May Budget Revise tomorrow and preliminary reports indicate that it will continue to be a challenging year for education. Dr. Scheer expressed his appreciation to the associations for reaching final agreements with 95% membership approval.

**Board Communications**

Trustee Paul Diffley remarked that although the press generally paints public schools with the same brush, this evening's presentations are an example of terrific student programs in our district. He commended teachers and students involved in the Virtual Enterprise program, Nighthawk Basketball team and the Robotics Club. Mr. Diffley reported attending two excellent musicals: Footloose performed by Murrieta Valley High School students and the Sound of Music performed by Murrieta Mesa High School students.

Trustee Kris Thomasian remarked that she is pleased that the Board is not voting to lay off any staff members. She also congratulated teachers and students that made presentations this evening. Ms. Thomasian referred to a recent Press Enterprise article which highlighted popular new bands coming out of this valley due to strong music programs within the school districts.

Trustee Margi Wray agreed with Chuck Smith that the retirement ceremony was very uplifting. She noted that unfortunately it will leave a huge void with the retirement of so many employees.
