### 5. Communications

#### a. Public Comment

John Vasquez commented on school curriculum and concerns about sexual education and critical race theory.

Clair Bolasky commented on the school climate and asked the district and Dr. Preston to pause on the inclusion process for special education students slated for next year. She said the teachers would like to take care of learning loss before implementing something new.

Major Tami Tordai stated that the JROTC program at Murrieta Valley High School is required to have a marksmanship range, per the MOU. She said the program is currently on probation as a result of not having the marksmanship range and that the program is in jeopardy of being discontinued within the next couple of years.

Jenni Botto commented on bullying incidents her child has encountered over the past few years.

**b. Employee Organizations Communication**

Kimberly Binning-Chevlin, President of Murrieta Educators' Association, said the 2021/22 school year has been an extremely tough one for their members, citing challenging student behavior. She reported that MEA is working with the co-teaching inclusion model and they are very hopeful it will go well. Mrs. Binning-Chevlin said changes to the structure of the classroom need to be implemented with care for the teachers. She reported that approximately 30 teachers are retiring this year.

Anna Leos, President of California School Employees Association, Chapter 223 reported that this is her last meeting as president. She referenced the co-teaching inclusion model and asked that administration considers the effects those types of changes have on the classified staff as well. She thanked Darren Daniel, Craig Frame and Leigh Lockwood for their partnership over these past few years.

Board member Takesha Cooper thanked Ms. Leos for her service as president of the Murrieta Chapter 223 of the California School Employees Association and heartfelt statements. Dr. Cooper reported attending the Ballet Folklorico performance at Murrieta Mesa High School, Thompson Middle School LPAC meeting, the AAPAC meeting, enjoying coffee from the Murrieta Summit coffee cart and spending some time in the ATP classroom.

Board member Linda Lunn highlighted Ms. Leos efforts to ensure CSEA members had opportunities for additional training. The enrichment programs will focus on developing the academic social, emotional and physical needs of students through hands-on, engaging learning experiences.
