**E. COMMUNICATIONS**

**1. Student Representative Reports**

High school student representatives reported on school academics, activities, athletics and upcoming events.

**2. Superintendent Report**

Superintendent Dr. Andrus stated that February was another excellent month in the District with numerous examples of good work happening for students. He complimented the new board members for their commitment to learning their roles and said all board members are very engaged in representing their constituents. Dr. Andrus reported that the District has reimplemented the recognition of employee service years by distributing anniversary pins to those employees who have fifteen years of service and above. He spoke about the February 27, 2023, annual Board Workshop where senior staff and board members established the goals and direction for the coming school year.

**3. Public Comment**

Matt Rhoads and Gabriella Saldana expressed concerns about the working conditions for DIS aides in the Districts.

Jen Reeves, Stephanie Holloway, Jennee Scharf, and Laurie Nielsen shared their concerns about political rhetoric being brought into our schools by board members Nicolas Pardue and Julie Vandegrift.

Rudy Krause commented on COVID science.

Angela Burch provided input about the long-standing positive working relationship the District and Murrieta Police Department have and her disappointment that Nicolas Pardue stated otherwise in a previous meeting.

Frances Burns said student behavior has greatly improved from last year and that in his twenty-seven years of teaching it was the first year he was able to mark outstanding citizenship on all of his students' report cards. He highlighted the need to continue to support students' emotional well-being.

Sue Stine commented on administration to student ratios on the middle school campuses and cell phone policies.

Kelly Parsons expressed her appreciation for the educators in the District and advocated for smaller class sizes and support for all teachers in the district.

Lucky Harutunian commented on parental rights to opt out of sex education.

Michelle Singleton provided support for the social science textbooks the district is considering for adoption.

Jennifer Berglund commented on the need to bring down class sizes in our schools.

Yvette Anthony commented on the desire to review new textbooks prior to adoption; poorly written safety plans; and requested the removal of Steven Schwartz's name from the slate of representatives to the California School Board Association Delegate Assembly for Subregion 18-A that the Board listed in G.7.

### **4. Employee Organization Reports**

Kimberly Binning-Chevlin, President of Murrieta Educators' Association, commented on the significant impact the high cost of living in the area, student emotional and mental health issues and higher than normal instances of misbehavior in the classroom are having on teachers. She reported participating in the February 27, 2023 Board workshop and attending CTA's Good Teaching conference.

### **5. Board Member Reports**

Board member Linda Lunn thanked the members of the public for providing valuable input. She highlighted student achievements in the Mock Trial competition and the Rotary speech contest. She expressed appreciation to Dale Velk for presenting active shooter training to the district. Mrs. Lunn reported attending many school site and county events, including unified sports and the VMHS performance of Shrek.

Board member Nicolas Pardue congratulated Murrieta Valley HS girls basketball team for making it to the CIF quarter finals. Mr. Pardue reported attending Mr. Nighthawk, MVHS open house and visiting Murrieta Canyon Academy, Thompson Middle School, Murrieta Elementary School and Cole Canyon Elementary School with Mr. Daniel. He commented on the amazing Career Technical Education programs offered in the District.

Board member Nancy Young congratulated Murrieta Mesa HS softball team for being number one and Murrieta Valley HS Mock Trial team for winning the Riverside County competition. She reported that Murrieta Valley Unified School District was recognized by the Riverside County Office of Education for our Unified Sports program.

Board member Julie Vandegrift expressed her appreciation for all the senior staff who have met with her to provide a deeper understanding of each of their divisions. She said the Saturday, March 4, 2023, board work session was very powerful and helped Board members identify effective governance traits and practices to help them work together as a team. Mrs. Vandegrift encouraged parents and community members to review the proposed new social science curriculum on display at the district support center.

He stated that total revenues are projected at \$358,177,791 with 69% of the budget funded by the Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF), 17% from the State, 7% from local, and 7% from Federal revenues; and total expenditures are projected at \$321,836,756 with 86% expended on salaries and benefits.
