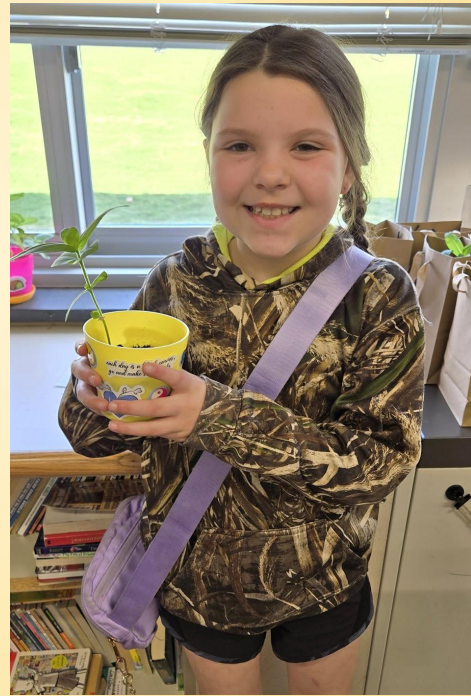


# Walbran Newsletter

# Music with Mrs. Marcinkowski

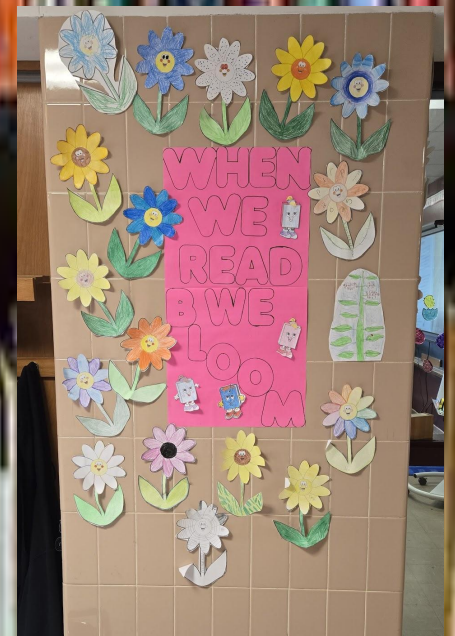
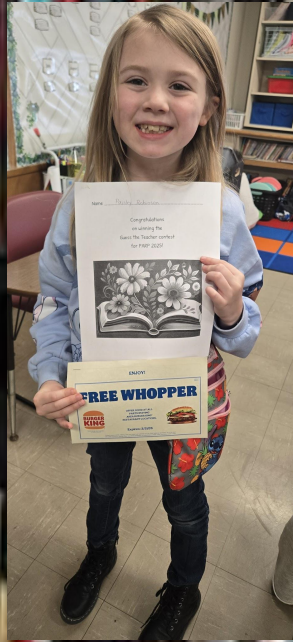
The 3rd Graders have been practicing very hard with their recorders in preparation for their concert in May.
