#### What led to the Ukraine Crisis?

You probably know what is going on in Europe: Russia is invading Ukraine. Many countries, including the United States have sent supplies to Ukraine, and have sanctioned Russia to hurt its economy. First, let's talk about how we got to this situation and why Russia is invading Ukraine.

It all started in the early 20th century. At that time, Ukraine was a part of Russia. All of Europe has been improving and industrializing, all except Russia. Some of Russia's population were serfs, a serf is like a farmer but working for someone else, not themself. Workers worked in hard conditions as well, and the Tsar would party hard all the time. It also didn't help that Russia had a humiliating defeat against Japan, and Russia would find itself in one of the biggest wars in history: World War I. So the people attempted a revolution, which failed. Then they started another revolution. Eventually they overthrew the Tsar, and a new government took place.

Russia was still fighting in WW1 and the people were tired of it. So Russia made peace with Germany saying that Russia must cede some of their territory and form a new German puppet state (a state that is controlled by another) out of it. Russia refused and instead removed their troops. When Germany realized that Russia removed their troops, 700,000 German troops pushed into Russia, and Germany demanded even more land to make new puppet states. One of these new puppet states was Ukraine. In 1917, the Russian Civil War started, which was the Bolsheviks vs Russia. After

Germany was defeated in 1918 all the German puppet states were granted independence, including Ukraine. The Bolsheviks tried to invade all of the new independent puppet states, and they did invade Ukraine. The Russian Civil War ended in 1922 where the Bolsheviks were victorious.

The Soviet Union collapsed in 1991 along with the independence of Ukraine and Russia. In 2014 Russia invaded Ukraine and annexed Crimea (took over and made part of Russia). Right now they are invading Ukraine again, why?

Well most of the Soviet Union republics form alliances with each other. The only European countries who didn't join the alliance were Estonia, Latvia, Lithuania, and they are all in NATO and in the EU. Ukraine is the only European republic. Vladimir Putin, who is president of Russia, wanted to invade Ukraine for many reasons. One of them is that he worries that Ukraine will join the EU and NATO. If there were war with NATO, NATO would be a larger front to deal with. On top of that, there is a flat surface in Europe that troops can push into and Russia wants to block this. Invading Ukraine will push their land into the Carpathian Mountains. Russia has been invaded many times by the French during the Napoleonic wars and Germany during WW2. Also Russia started in Ukraine.

Ukraine troops are fighting really hard and Ukraine has a decently big military. With the sanctions hitting Russia, it will give Ukraine a chance to win the war.







grades, and I am proud of myself. For trimester three I would really encourage people to not stress, and never give up. Just don't spend all-nighters trying to




study. This is the last trimester of the year. Try to keep up good grades, but also have fun!



The police asked us: "what were we doing there?" We said we were looking for the killer, but they did not believe us. We were now suspects.


