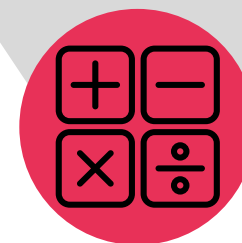

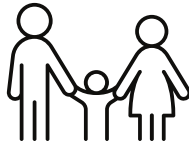

COMMUNICATION

Open and ongoing communication is promoted among home, school, and community.

- An Annual Title 1 Meeting will be held.
- School based information and documents will be available to families via the CSE website and through School Messenger email.
- Parents will be provided access to staff through email and phone during the hours of 8:40-4:10 each day.
- Communication will be available in easy to understand formats. If translation is needed, interpreter services are available through the CCPS Interpretation & Translation Services department at 410-386-1699.



PARENTING

Parenting skills are fostered and supported.

- The school will provide materials and workshops to help families improve their academic achievement.
- These include Parent Focus Groups as well as Family Events.
- The school will collaborate with the PTA to provide meaningful support activities and learning activities.
- Attend at least one school event yearly.
- Attend at least one school conference each year and communicate concerns with your child's teacher.

VOLUNTEERING

Parents, families and community members are welcome at CSE. Their support and assistance are encouraged and recognized.

- The school will provide a variety of opportunities for trained family members to volunteer at school or participate at home.
- These opportunities may include volunteering in a classroom, making learning materials at home or acting as chaperones for class trips.

STUDENT LEARNING

Parents, families, and the community play an integral role in assisting student learning.

- Students should arrive to school on time and prepared with the supplies needed for the day.
- Students should read at home daily, independently when possible.
- The school, families and students will work together to implement the Home-School Learning Compact.
- Student achievement on school and county-based assessments will be shared with families through interim reports, quarterly report cards and conferences.
- Parents will be provided results from state assessments annually.
- Families are provided with 24/7 access to student grades through the Online Home Access Center.
