Fast Facts About The Hill

- ◎ Typically 12-13 Classes EACH of 1st & 2nd Grade
- ◎ Academics:
 - Reading & Writing = 120+ minutes/day
 - Math = 75+ minutes/day
 - Science or Social Studies = 40 minutes/day
 - Specials: Music, PE, Art, and Library
- ◎ Lunch/Recess = approximately 25 minutes each (AM/PM Recess = 15 minutes)
- ◎ Social/Emotional Needs
 - 2 School Counselors & 1 School Psychologist
 - Social Thinking & Zones of Regulation

Students' School Day

8:45AM	Students begin entering the building & report to classrooms.*
9:00AM	School begins for all students. Tardy bell rings.
3:41PM	Walkers and bike riders are dismissed to the playground.*
3:42PM	Car riders are dismissed to the gym and exit to playground.*
3:45PM	Bus riders are called over the PA in order of arrival and dismissed to bus lot.*

*=High Traffic Times! Please proceed through the parking lot and front circle with great care!

Tardy: Students who arrive tardy must walk into the Main Office with an adult to be signed in. Students who arrive after 11:00AM are considered absent for a half-day.



Arrival & Dismissal


Car Riders:

- ◎ All car traffic should enter the **Stow Road entrance** .
- ◎ Turn right into the **front circle** .
- ◎ Proceed to the **drop-off/pick-up area at Door D near the playground** .
- ◎ All students should enter/exit their vehicle using the **passenger side** door.

**To keep everyone safe, please stay in line and do not pull around other cars.*

Bus Riders:

- ◎ Our bus lot is on the **Middleton Road side** of the building.
- ◎ Students enter/exit through **Doors I & J** .



Absences, Leaving Early, & Explorer Zone

Absences: All absences must be called in to the Attendance Line (330) 653-1300. This line is open 24 hours every day. You may call at any time. Please provide a doctor's note for any appointments.

Leaving Early: If your child needs to leave during the school day, please write a note to the teacher indicating what time the student will be picked up and who will be picking up the student. Students must be signed out by an adult in the Main Office. For everyone's safety and security, please have your ID ready to present.




As school counselors, we are here to help with the social, emotional, academic and behavioral well-being of all students. This “whole child” approach is achieved by providing monthly guidance lessons, small group counseling, and individual counseling services that are both proactive and reactive in nature.

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- **Classroom Guidance Lessons** provide developmental and preventive approaches to topics such as feelings, social skills, empathy, conflict resolution, goal setting, bullying, diversity, career exploration, test taking strategies, and personal safety. We use Michelle Garcia Winner's **Social Thinking** methodology and Leah Kuypers' **Zones of Regulation** to guide these lessons.
 - **Small Group Counseling** groups address issues including friendship, worry, self-esteem, anger, divorce, bullying, grief, transitioning to a new school or new grade level, and managing stress. All new students to the district meet with a school counselor for an orientation. Teachers and/or parents can request a student be included in a small group. The school counselor will obtain parent permission before including the student in a small group. Groups meet for 6 to 8 weeks.

- **Individual Counseling** helps students learn strategies to cope with their feelings, manage behavior and get along with others so that they can be happy, safe and successful students. Teachers and/or parents may refer a student for individual counseling. Students may also ask to speak to a school counselor by leaving a note in our mailbox in the main office.
- **Consultation and Collaboration** : The school counselors consult and collaborate with teachers, parents and administrators to ensure the academic, social, emotional and behavioral needs of students are met. In addition, the school counselors can provide direction and referrals if parents choose to access additional outside support services as needed. Consultation with staff and parents is an important part of the support process as we all work together to create a safe and caring environment for students at school and at home.

Room parents work with the teacher to plan parties.


PS-Grade 5 follow the same menu using the Nut-Free Snack List. Games/prizes may not include food items.
