**VI. Presentation: Great Oaks Update – Toya Wall, Great Oaks Career Campus Board Designee**

Mrs. Wall provided an update on Great Oaks enrollment, report card results, Comprehensive Annual Financial Report, and the FY24 Audit.

**VII. CAC Presentation: Social Media and Its Impact on Students and Families**

Study team members Julie Christner, Alison Dupee (in memoriam) Chad Harness, Ian Klingler, Mary Ellen Knickel, Cathy Ramstetter, and Dave Menninger presented their findings from examining the impact of social media on students and families. The committee worked with a particular focus on insights from the book The Anxious Generation and the Netflix mini-series *The Social Dilemma* to explore the challenges and implications of social media usage on family dynamics, mental health and societal behavior. Through reading the book and watching the series, surveying parents and reviewing policies and practices from other school districts, the committee recommended to curtail device usage, promote play-based learning, and engage students, staff and parents on policy change.

**VIII. 2025-2026 Textbook Adoption Presentation: K – 12 World Languages**

World Language teachers Liz Knopp, Julia Saadallah and Todd Wegenhart highlighted alignment to standards, future focus skills, and differentiation in proposed textbooks for Spanish, Latin and French.

**IX. State Biennium Budget Update: Public School Funding**

Ronda Johnson, District Treasurer, provided an update on the State biennium budget process, including legislative proposals from the Governor and the Ohio House of Representatives that will reduce state and local funding for Wyoming City Schools and public schools across Ohio.



