## COMMUNITY

The Owen J. Roberts School District is located approximately thirty-five miles northwest of Philadelphia in Chester County. Its seven townships (North Coventry, East Coventry, South Coventry, East Nantmeal, Warwick, East and West Vincent) cover approximately one hundred square miles. It is predominantly a rural/suburban residential community with abundant opportunities for cultural and recreation activities. The district currently enrolls over 4,500 students from kindergarten to twelfth grade.

## CURRICULUM

Course offering represent a flexible and comprehensive curriculum that is offered on four levels (Advanced Placement, International Baccalaureate, Honors, College Preparatory and Standard). A typical high school student's schedule will include between six and seven credits of coursework per year. Courses are taught on a traditional schedule with 45 minute class periods. The high school program is enhanced through the use of Technology, Cooperative Education, Dual Enrollment courses, Hybrid courses, Online courses and Gifted Education. Students in grade 10-12 may also attend the Technical College High School on a half day schedule.

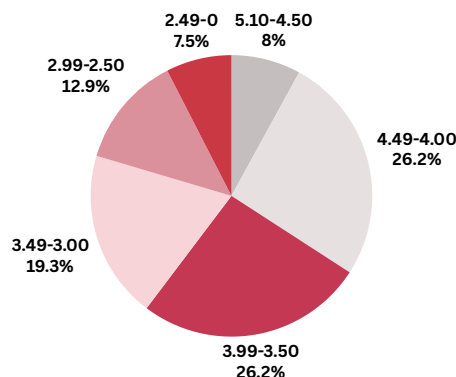

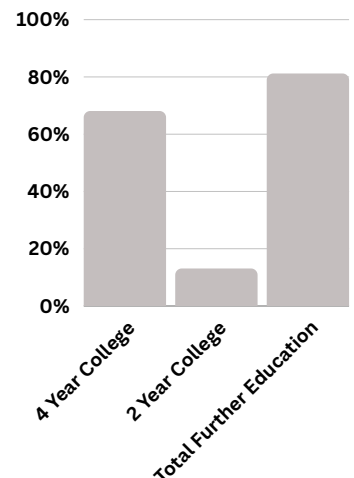

**Grade Point Average Calculations**

Final grades on the report card and transcript are reported on the 100 point scale. Weighted grade point average is computed by converting the final grade in a course to a point value and multiplying by the credit received. The highest possible point value for the four levels of coursework are: AP (5.3), Honors (5.0), College Prep (4.5), and Standard (4.0). All courses receiving a numerical grade are included in grade point average. Grade point average is cumulative and includes only courses taken at Owen J. Roberts High School.
