Rules and Code of Conduct for Intramurals

Purpose of Intramurals

The goal of intramurals is to create a positive environment and experience for all participants. Each person has the responsibility to demonstrate respect to all students and adults and participate in a respectful manner. Safety is most important and care of equipment must also be demonstrated. Individuals whose behavior disrupts the positive experiences of other participants will be dismissed from that specific intramural program. The North Coventry expectations for being respectful to ourselves and others, as well as the school are in full effect, even during after school activities such as intramurals.

Be a Good Sport

At the onset of each intramural season, the code of conduct will be reviewed by the staff member running the program. All participants, and their guardians, will be expected to sign the code of conduct indicating their understanding of the rules and consequences if the rules are not followed.

Snacks may only be eaten prior to the start of intramurals while attendance is taken.

Use kind words and comments. Trash talking, cursing or calling of names will not be permitted.

Participants should maintain a positive attitude in both times of adversity and success.

Consequences*:

1st offense: student receives a warning

2nd offense: parent is informed of incident by staff member running the intramural program and the principal will be notified

3rd offense: student is dismissed from the program, parents and principal are notified

**Seriousness & circumstances of offense may result in immediate removal from the intramural activity.*
