## **Adult-to-Child Ratio Required for Pool Parties**

Swim participants must not exceed number of attendees listed above due to proper lifeguard to swimmer ratios.

**Ages 3 – 4 : 1 to 1 Ratio** – 1 Adult in the water for every child. Group size is limited to 12 children.

**Ages 5 – 6 : 1 to 3 Ratio** – 1 Adult in the water for every 3 children. Group size is limited to 20 children.

**Ages 7+ : 1 to 5 Ratio** – One adult on deck actively supervising for every five children. If children cannot pass swim test, adult must be in the water. Group size is limited to 25 children.

Children must pass swim test to use the deep end.

Children who cannot touch in the shallow end and/or who do not pass the swim test must wear a life jacket (provided by YMCA).
