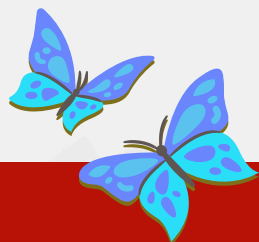
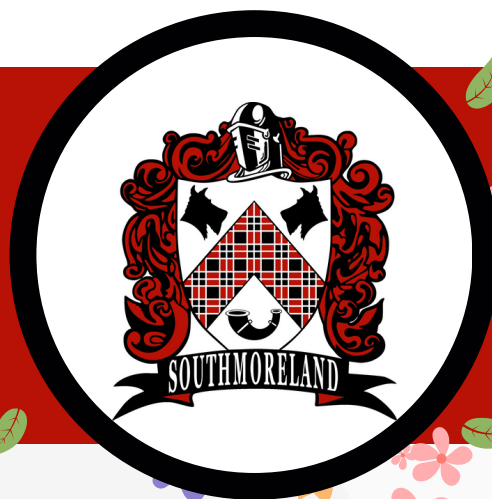

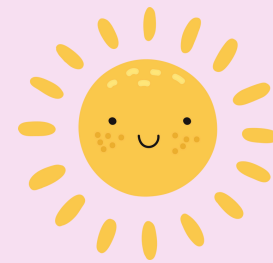


WHAT'S HAPPENING AT SOUTHMORELAND
