We need to have that service, somebody to just come in so the students in our building can get glasses. We have a lot of kids squinting who cannot see. I have stuff falling from my ceiling. We come in and there is paint sitting on the seats. We have the electrical outlets completely open and hanging from the wall. I've put in for it to be corrected and it still hasn't been corrected. We need to have that fixed. As a teacher, I'm hoping you come up with a new salary guide so that we all can get raises. This is some nonsense that's going on. It makes no sense that we have to struggle to make ends meet. 22 years in the district. We need a fair contract that shows a salary guide where we're getting raises so that we can take care of our families. Thank you.


