

INFORMATION ITEMS

- 20-A38. Approved partnership between School No. 5, Don Bosco Academy and International High School and Ramapo College, providing busing and educational experiences that are place-based which will lead the students to develop habits of lifelong learning and to excel academically.
- 20-A39. Approved the partnership between Great Falls Academy and Fordham University that enables students from Fordham University to complete their internship hours under the supervision of certified staff members from both Fordham University and Paterson Public Schools, to expose students and staff to some of the cutting edge strategies and techniques for impacting lives, at no cost to the district.
- 20-A40. Approved the partnership with AAA, Northeast of Northern New Jersey, and the Academy of Earth and Space Science (PANTHER), to participate in a presentation designed to expose students to real-life scenarios that will help in improving their driving skills by reducing their driving risks through anticipating situations and making safe, well-informed decisions, on January 24, 2019, at no cost to the district.
- 20-A41. Approved Eastside High School hosting the first Martin Luther King, Jr., Girls Basketball Showcase to provide positive exposure to players, and permit rare, out-of-conference matchups within this one day format, with all NFHS and NJSIAA rules being followed, including the assignment of approved NJSIAA officials/referees, at an amount not to exceed \$2,820.00.
- 20-A42. Approved entering into an agreement with The Christopher Barron Live Life Foundation to present the “Christopher’s Comic Inspirations” workshops at School No. 27, to teach students how to tell a story with sequential illustrations, create plots and write dialog, beginning the week of February 11, 2020, completely funded by the Christopher Barron Live Life Foundation.
- 20-A43. Approved the annual BTMF Tricky Tray on May 8, 2020, with donations being accepted from various community businesses, at the John F. Kennedy Educational Complex, and a Flapjack fundraiser to be held at Applebee’s in Totowa, on January 25, 2020, with tickets being sold at \$12.00 each.
- 20-A44. Approved acceptance of a grant from the Passaic County Department of Human Services, Division of Mental Health and Addiction Services, to use only towards Mental Health Services, for the 2019-2020 school year, in the amount of \$17,500.00.
- 20-A45. Approved acceptance of a donation from DonorsChoose.org of five new Chrome Books and headphones to enhance student learning at Alexander Hamilton Academy.
- 20-A46. Approved acceptance of a donations from Passaic County Sheriff’s officers and volunteers of gifts for students at School No. 2, School No. 14, Dale Avenue and Edward W. Kilpatrick Schools, and will entertain students with singing on Sunday, December 15, 2019.

- 20-A47. Approved entering into a consultant agreement with Deborah L. Keys Write of The Write Keys 2 Consulting, LLC, to provide professional development in the area of governance best practices, on January 10-11, 2020, at an amount not to exceed \$4,500.00.
