



Flagler Technical College Money Back Guarantee Program

Flagler Technical College is proud to announce its Money-Back Guarantee program. As part of House Bill 1507 and the Reimagining Education and Career Help Act (REACH), students who complete any of the Money-Back Guarantee programs, meet eligibility requirements, and are not employed within six months after graduation, can request a refund of their tuition. The Money-Back Guarantee program is for tuition only and does not include any other costs associated with participation in the Postsecondary Career and Technical education program including lab fees, testing fees, supplies or materials. Self-pay students are eligible to apply for the Money-Back Guarantee program. The Money-Back Guarantee program does not apply to any portions of tuition paid by an outside agency or scholarship. The Money-Back Guarantee programs are in high demand in our local area. The following programs have been identified as Money-Back Guarantee programs:

Commercial Vehicle Driving
Heavy Equipment Operator Technician
Cosmetology

Students are only eligible for a refund for out-of-pocket tuition expenses. Students must meet **ALL** of the requirements listed below to be eligible for a refund:

- **Student attendance** - Student must have attended 90% or more scheduled hours for the entirety of Commercial Vehicle Driving and Heavy Equipment Operations Technician, and 100% including make up hours for Cosmetology.
- **Student program performance** - Student must have earned a B+ (87-89) or higher on all coursework and participated in an internship or work study program.
- **Certification** – Student must have passed the industry certification exam in Commercial Vehicle Driving and Cosmetology programs.
- **Career Fair/Career Day attendance** - Student must have attended a career fair.
- **Job search documentation** - Student must show documentation that they have applied for a minimum of 12 jobs and have attended scheduled interviews. Student must be available to work.

- **Development of a student career plan with the institution's career services department- Student must have done the following:**
 - Met with FTC's Student Services Specialist at least once during enrollment
 - Submitted an updated resume (on file)
 - Completed the FTC exit survey
 - Made contact with the Student Services Specialist for additional assistance if not employed within 3 months after graduation
 - Met all other requirements
- **Student must possess** a valid driver's license, have no criminal background and be eligible to work in the United States.
- **Student must submit the Money Back Guarantee Application with support documentation no later than one year from date of program completion.**
