

HHS Counseling Results Report

2024-2025

Grade Level Blitzes

10th Grade

- Counselors and Future Center staff met with each 10th grade student during registration
- 19% increase in students able to identify their graduation status

11th Grade

- 69% of 11th graders met individually with their counselor and a Future Center representative to discuss this graduation status and future goals

12th Grade

- 77% of 12th graders met individually with their school counselor and a Future Center representative during 12th Grade Blitz.

Signs of Suicide (SOS) Lessons

Rationale:

According to the CDC, suicide is the 2nd leading cause of death for teens. Through participation in the Signs of Suicide lessons, students are trained to recognize the warning signs for individuals who may be contemplating suicide and are empowered to respond, using the ACT (Acknowledge-Care-Tell) steps, to help connect those experiencing distress to critical and potentially life-saving support.

Who participated?

- 263 9th grade and ML students
- 168 10th grade students
- 253 11th and 12th grade students



Pre/Post- Survey Results:

“I know how to respond to someone who is showing signs of suicide or telling me they are considering suicide.”

9th & Multilingual	69.6%	71.1%
10th	75%	82.1%
11th & 12th	79.2%	85.7%
