RESOURCE TEACHER-PHYSICAL EDUCATION

JOB SUMMARY:

Under the supervision of the Executive Director of Operations and Instruction Services and Support, the Resource Teacher-Physical Education assists in developing and implementing curriculum and training staff in the use of age-appropriate skill and fitness activities that align with the California Physical Education Content Standards. The Resource Teacher will work with students at multiple school sites. Working with other District Resource Teachers, he/she will be responsible for mentoring and modeling follow-up activities for classroom teachers to fulfill the state mandate of 200 minutes of physical education every ten days.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

- Provides direct instruction to students.
- Implements physical education programs collaboratively with teachers at multiple school sites.
- Develops and implements physical education curriculum and activities for students.
- Monitors student progress.
- Provides inservice training and presentations to District staff.
- Assists in the development of training materials and manuals.
- Maintains a variety of service-related records and prepares reports.
- Travels to school sites as required and maintains regular contact with other certificated staff.
- Attends meetings and conferences as assigned.
- Demonstrates professional ability to relate to staff and students.
- Demonstrates ability to implement effective positive behavior management systems.
- Performs other duties as assigned.

- Experience in the field of physical education.
- Strong written and oral communication skills.
