STEAM Studio Resource Teacher

JOB SUMMARY:

Under the direction of the Director of Innovation, the STEAM Studio Resource Teacher will design and facilitate cross-curricular and authentic learning experiences tied to classroom standards. Using the design thinking process, the STEAM Studio Resource Teacher will design and model inquiry-based learning experiences for teachers that promote critical thinking, creativity, collaboration, and communication for their students. They will also plan and implement coaching and professional learning opportunities for school site teachers.

- Serve as an educational innovator for the district, promoting the skills of creativity, critical thinking, problem-solving, and communication.
- Work collaboratively with department and instructional services and support team, principals, grade level teams, school site committees and/or instructional leadership teams to implement instructional programs at school sites.
- Utilize research-based methodologies to increase student-centered learning experiences which provide choice, promote agency, and build upon student strengths.
- Stay current on latest technology trends and tools and integrate them into the design of standards-based learning experiences for students and staff.
- Enhance student learning experiences by partnering with professional experts across diverse disciplines.
- Serve as a curator of resources for districtwide innovation initiatives.
- Skillfully plan, develop, embed, and implement interdisciplinary, hands-on, project-based learning through design thinking.
- Develop, plan, and provide professional learning opportunities related to the area of responsibility.
- Participate in professional learning to meet the needs of the department and school sites.
- Demonstrate professional ability to interact with, relate to, and support staff and students.
- Ensure effective communication to develop rich, reciprocal relationships with school sites, district staff, and the greater community.
- Travel to school sites as required.
- Attend meetings and conferences as assigned.
- Maintain a variety of service-related records to provide evidence of implementation and feedback for grant records.
- Performs other duties as assigned.
