**JOB SUMMARY:**

Under the supervision of the Assistant Superintendent of Innovation and Instruction, provides an innovative educational program for pupils in upper grades or a combination thereof, and assists in other school programs as assigned. Creates a flexible elementary-grade program and a class environment favorable to creativity, learning, and personal growth. Establishes effective rapport with pupils' that motivates them to develop skills, attitudes, and knowledge focusing on their strengths, interests, and values while exposing them to the world of work and career development opportunities. Establishes good relationships with parents and other staff members. Supervises instructional assistants, student teachers, and parent volunteers when applicable.

**ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:**

- Provides learning activities related to the San Diego County work force economy sectors to students in a makerspace/classroom setting utilizing materials related to the Common Core and Next Generation Science Standards.
- Develops lesson plans, instructional materials, and provides individualized and small group instruction in order to adapt the curriculum to the needs of each student.
- Translates lesson plans into learning experiences to best utilize the available time for instruction.
- Establishes and maintains standards of student behavior needed to achieve a functional learning atmosphere in the classroom.
- Communicates with various District stakeholders in a variety of ways including social media.
- Supports individual student strengths, interests, and values by cooperating and collaborating with other professional staff members.
- Creates an effective environment for learning through functional and attractive displays, bulletin boards, and interest centers.
- Maintains professional competence through participation in inservice education activities provided by the District and school, and/or in self-selected professional growth activities.
- Attends a reasonable number of meetings and evening school programs that require student supervision. Contract says no more than two evening programs for a total of five hours.
- Participates in curriculum development programs within the station of assignment, which may require collaboration with District personnel and outside individuals who are partners in the workforce sector in the school of assignment and/or on a District level.
- Shares in the sponsorship of student activities and participates in faculty committees.
- Plans and coordinates the work of Instructional Assistants and other paraprofessionals.
- Teaches diverse learners and is well-versed in instructional strategies for serving a wide range of students using GLAD and SDAIE strategies.
- Has had specialized training for engineering curriculum.
