**PAINTER – ENTRY LEVEL**

---

**JOB SUMMARY:**

Under general supervision, performs entry level work in outside and inside painting of new and old buildings, structures, and equipment; mixes paints and matches colors; cleans, sands, putties, patches surfaces, and otherwise prepares surfaces for painting; uses brushes, roller, and spray gun to apply paint; may erect and work from scaffold; and performs other duties as assigned.

**ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:**

- Paints schools, education center, walls, doors, trims, blacktops, equipment, furniture, ceilings, and vehicles.
- Purchases paint equipment and paint.
- Documents work orders, shipping tags, and requisitions for warehouse.
- Removes graffiti, paint, rust, miscellaneous paints, and solvents from schools.
- Prioritizes work orders and graffiti removal.
- Operates paint equipment.
- Estimates time and material for job(s).
- Hangs wallpaper.
- Repairs wallpaper.
- Transports self, material, and equipment.
- Encapsulates lead-based paint.

**ESSENTIAL JOB REQUIREMENTS - QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Evidence of two years successful experience as an apprentice or helper under the supervision and training of a journey level employee in the same field.
- Ability to read blueprints, estimate time and material for job orders, train and direct efforts of others effectively, drive a light truck or van to and from jobs, and perform in the official absence of the Trades II in the same field.
- Knowledge of methods, tools, equipment, materials, and means of transportation for the particular journey level tasks.
- High school diploma or GED required.
- Graduation from a recognized trade school, or completion of equivalent training and experience.
- Must possess a valid California driver's license. Must have a good driving record. Must be insurable under the District's insurance program and must maintain insurability.
- Must be willing to carry a pager and respond to off-hour calls. May be required to work weekends.
